2021 - 2022 COVID 19 PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES FOR RAPID TESTING

- 1. The Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator must be notified by the teacher or parent that a scholar has been exposed or tested positive for COVID.
- The Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator must notify the
 Administration about any scholar, teacher, or parent who has been exposed or tested positive for
 COVID.
- 3. The Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator will notify its local health department, in compliance with federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including confidentiality requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- 4. The Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator after receiving information and documentation that any teacher, staff member, scholar, or visitor at Academy of Dallas Charter School has tested positive for COVID-19, the Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator must submit a report to the Texas Department of State Health Services via an online form. The report must be submitted each Monday for the prior seven days (Monday-Sunday).

5. Academy of Dallas Charter School Health Coordinator must be consistent with following

the state guidelines for COVID 19 Rapid Testing. The School Health Coordinator must notify all

teachers and staff who has been exposed to a scholar, parent or another staff, who tested positive

for COVID.

6. All Academy of Dallas staff, scholars and visitors are required to wear a mask before

entering the building until further notice.

7. Students and staff who are exposed must be tested for COVID by Health Coordinator and

have the option to quarantine for 10 days if negative. (Remote Conferencing will be offered to

students upon parent request)

8. Students and staff who tested positive must quarantine for 10 days and then are retested.

Students and staff must have a negative result before returning to school. (Remote Conferencing

will be offered to students)

9. For staff who are not fully vaccinated who meet the close contact threshold with a

COVID19 positive individual, it is recommended that the staff remain off campus during the stay-

at-home period.

10. For staff who meet the close contact threshold with a COVID-19 positive individual, if

these staff continue to work on campus, rapid testing must be performed at the start of the day, at

least once every other day until the end of day 10.
